## WELCOME TO MPAA

Thank you for joining Mid-Pennine Arts Association. As a member you are entitled to many benefits which include admission to our events and activities at reduced prices, discounts at local shops and theatres, free use of our hire equipment, free advance mailing of our seasonal brochure and much more.

This booklet is your handbook giving full details of these benefits, how you can use them and, where appropriate, under what conditions. We do hope that you will use your membership privileges to the full and if you need any further information do give us a ring or pop in to see us at The Gallery Downstairs - you'll always be very welcome.

## MEMBERSHIP CARD

Your membership card is the key to all the benefits detailed in this booklet. Please sign your card and keep it in a safe place as you will need to produce it to claim the special offers. Should you lose your card, please let us know at once so that we can cancel your old card and issue you with a new one. Please remember that your card and the benefits are not transferable. Also, don't forget to let us know of any change of address.

## FREE ADVANCE MAILING

All our members receive free advance mailing of our seasonal brochure giving full details of forthcoming events. To ensure that your brochure always arrives on time do let us know promptly of any change of address.

### PRIORITY BOOKING

Because you receive advance details of our events and activities you can book your tickets for events or places on our workshops and excursions before the general public, guaranteeing your place. Please make use of this facility as often places on workshops and excursions and tickets for certain performances are likely to be booked early and are sometimes oversubscribed.

## INVITATIONS TO GALLERY PREVIEWS

The Gallery Downstairs is fast becoming a major centre for the best in contemporary arts and crafts. We always hold a private view for our members where we invite you to join us for a glass of wine (or fruit juice) and to experience the delights of each new exhibition in the relaxed and friendly atmosphere of The Gallery Downstairs. Where possible, we also invite the exhibiting artists to join us for these evenings and you always have a chance to meet with the staff and discuss any aspects of the arts with them.

## TICKET VOUCHERS

All members receive ticket vouchers each worth £1 off the admission price to MPAA events. We operate a two tier pricing system, a full price and a concessionary price for those in full time education, the unemployed, senior citizens and the registered disabled. As members, you can use your vouchers to claim £1 off the appropriate price for you. If you wish to claim the discount off the concessionary price you may be asked to produce evidence of your concessionary status in addition to your membership card.

MPAA occasionally jointly promotes an event with another organisation. It may not always be possible to offer member discounts on these events. Details of which events you may use your vouchers will appear in each season's brochure.

Ticket vouchers are issued when you renew your membership in April, or when you join. They are only valid in the membership year in which they are issued and our membership year runs from 1st April to 31st March. Unfortunately we cannot give credit for any unused vouchers and vouchers are not transferable.

### HOW TO BOOK TICKETS

Tickets for all performances and places on workshops and excursions can be booked in advance at The Gallery Downstairs, Yorke Street, Burnley, BB11 1HD telephone Burnley (0282) 21986, which is open Monday to Friday 10.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m., Saturday and Bank Holidays 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. and Sunday 2.00 to 4.00 p.m. You can pay by cash, cheque (made payable to MPAA) or by Access and Visa credit cards. If you make a postal booking please remember to send a stamped, self-addressed envelope. Telephone bookings can be made by Access or Visa credit cards.

Bookings can also be made at any of our ticket agents throughout the Mid-Pennine area and they are listed opposite.

In order to claim your member discount please present your vouchers when you buy tickets in person either at The Gallery Downstairs, at our ticket agents or at the Box Office. If you are booking by post, just enclose your vouchers with your cheque. If you are booking by 'phone please quote the voucher numbers and hand them in at the Box Office when you collect your tickets on the night of the performance.

Please remember that we are not able to exchange tickets or to offer refunds. If you are collecting tickets at the Box Office please try to arrive early as this avoids the rush. If you do arrive late it may be necessary for you to wait until there is a suitable break in the performance before you can be admitted. This avoids causing disturbance to the rest of the audience and performers.

## FREE LOANS OF EQUIPMENT

MPAA has a comprehensive range of equipment for hire. In general we are able to offer the equipment for hire free of charge to our group and corporate members. (In certain circumstances individual and family members may also be able to borrow equipment free of charge, so please check with us if you have a very special need). We operate on a first come, first served basis so do book early. You can reserve equipment by phoning Burnley 21986 during normal office hours 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. Monday to We do ask that all users of the equipment Friday. arrange for its collection and return. You are asked to bring sufficient assistance with you for carrying items as our staff are not always available We do insist that borrowers undertake to to help. insure and if necessary replace any items damaged or If we have to effect repairs due to misuse of the equipment we will have to charge borrowers for You will be asked to sign a loan agreement form setting out these conditions.

Obviously our resources are limited and it may be that the equipment you need is already in use and not available. We do have contacts with other sources of equipment most of which are commercial hirers of equipment.

The free loan service for members works well because our members look after the equipment, collect it at the time agreed and most importantly return it on time and in good condition for the next user. Without the co-operation of all borrowers the scheme could not operate. Please help us to ensure that it is used to its maximum by taking care of the equipment.

All hire charges are per day unless otherwise stated. Members may borrow most equipment free of charge. Unless a member hire fee is indicated, no charge is made to members. Non-Members are asked to pay a deposit prior to hiring which will be refunded when the equipment is returned in good condition. Non-Members will also be asked to provide two means of identification such as driving licence, passport, utilities bill, etc. We ask all borrowers to report any defects or operating difficulties with the equipment so that we can rectify any faults as soon as is possible.

All inflatables, except the small triangle, are supplied with a fan to inflate the structure. The small triangle can be operated with a domestic vacuum cleaner that blows!

For members to qualify for the free or reduced hire charges the inflatables must be supervised by some one who has attended an MPAA operating and safety workshop. Workshops are held annually and are free. We do stress that hirers should bring sufficient people with them to carry the structures as our staff may not be available to assist. All inflatables other than the tortoise can be transported in family hatch back or estate cars, the tortoise will need a van, larger estate car or Range Rover sized vehicle.


Full operating instructions are available for all hirers.
